



Honkoji Temple

The official name of Honkoji Temple is Soto Sect Zuiunzan Honkoji. Founded by the MATSUDAIRA Tadasada, first head of the Fukozu MATSUDAIRA family (one of the eighteen Mikawa MATSUDAIRA). Kishoeiin Daiosho (great preceptor) was the first chief priest of the temple. The principal image is a Buddha called Shakanyorai, and the flanking images are Jizo Bosatsu (Jizo Bodhisattva) and Senju Kannon Bosatsu (Thousand-Armed Kannon Buddhisattva for life extension and easy birth. It is also called Migawari (sacrificial) Kannon, and was built in 1528 as a prayer place and a family cemetery for the Fukozu MATSUDAIRA family until now. The Tsukiji-bei (a wall made of rammed earth) that collapsed due to the Mikawa earthquake still remains at the Higashi-gobyosho (eastern stone mausoleum).
