Combustible garbage

Items

Kitchen refuse, rubber, leather goods (bags and shoes, etc.), stuffed toys, cold storage insulators, desiccants, cassette tapes, videotapes, disposable diapers, dirty paper containers and packages, disposable body warmers
Plastic Items (CDs, DVDs, air-tight containers, etc.)

How to put out garbage

- Put out garbage at the designated station.
- Be sure to use garbage bags designated by Kota-Cho.
- Drain water fully from kitchen refuse.
- Put out garbage no later than 8:00 am on the designated collection day.

Available in retailers such as supermarkets and convenience stores.

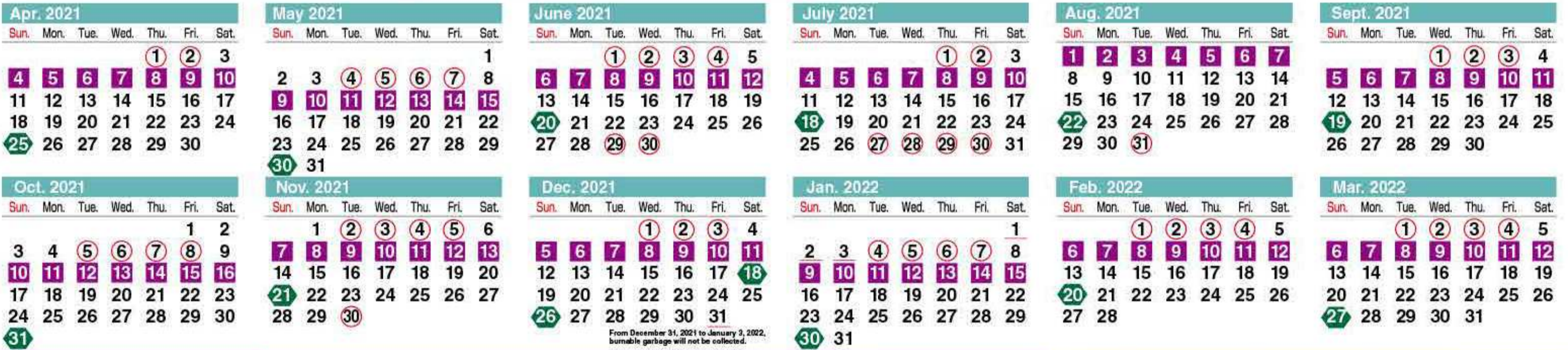

Separation Division	Items	How to put out garbage	Collection container
Returnable bottles	1.8-liter-sized sake bottles, beer bottles	● Use up the contents and rinse the inside lightly. ● Remove all caps. ● Separate broken items into earthenware and glass.	Light-blue container
Other bottles (for beverage)	Bottles for beverages other than returnable ones (Bottles for juice, jam, or seasoning)	● Use up the contents and wash out. ● Do not crush. ● Put can lids in the other metals/other aluminum category.	
Cans for foods and beverages (Aluminum cans and steel cans)	Aluminum and steel cans for foods and beverages such as carbonated soft drinks, beer, confectionary, dried laver seaweed, and milk.	● Remove caps and place in plastic containers and packages. ● Use up the contents and rinse out. ● Crush before putting out. ● Remove labels and dispose of as plastic containers and packages.	Green mesh
Plastic bottles	Plastic bottles for beverages, Japanese sake, and soy sauce, etc.	● Use up the contents, wash and dry. ● Put out dirty items as burnable garbage. ● When disposing large pieces of styrofoam, break into smaller pieces.	White mesh
Plastic containers and packages	(Plastic) marked articles Plastic bottles for cleanser or shampoo, plastic bottle caps, packs, colored trays, plastic bags, mesh nets, cups for Natto or mushrooms, white trays and Styrofoam, etc.	● Rinse them lightly. (Drink caps and can lids)	Gray container
Other aluminum articles	Aluminum-made cookware (pots, kettles, frying pans, etc.) Drink caps, can lids, aluminum foil, etc.	● For umbrellas, tear off the fabric and take off the handle wherever possible. If it cannot be taken off, put out it as is. Remove others than metal before putting out, wherever possible.	Gray container
Other metals	Metals excluding food/beverage cans, aerosol cans, and other aluminum items	● Use up the contents. ● Put out mixed paper for recycling in your area if possible. Put out dirty items as burnable garbage.	
Mixed paper (paper containers and packages + miscellaneous used paper)	Paper boards, wrapping paper, bags, cups, cylinder and box forms, miscellaneous used paper	● Put only dry batteries.	Brown bags
Dry batteries	Dry batteries	● Put them out without breaking.	Orange container
Fluorescent tubes	Fluorescent tubes (round- and straight-types) Fluorescent poles, mercury thermometers	● Use up the contents.	Gray container
Spray cans	Steel spray cans, cassette-type gas cylinders, cosmetic spray cans, etc.	● Take out only ceramic and glass wares without breaking.	
Earthenware and Glass	China, broken glass, cosmetic bottles, etc.	● For large waste which cannot be placed in a container, put it out on a bulky-waste collection day.	
Other noncombustible waste (Non-Combustible Garbage Not Listed Above)	Non-Combustible Garbage Not Applicable to the Above Categories. Nonburnable waste made of various materials, electronic thermometers, electric bulbs, and lighters, etc.		

Items that cannot be disposed of by the town: Four types of household appliances (air conditioners, TVs, refrigerators, freezers, washing machines and dryers), computers, motorcycles, small rechargeable batteries, button cell batteries, ink cartridges, other items difficult to dispose of, garbage generated from business operations, etc. ※Regarding other items difficult to dispose of and disposal methods, please consult with the Kota Municipal Office Environment Division.

Bulky waste

Self carrying-in

- ◆ Application acceptance days: One week/Month (marked days in the following calendar).
 - ◆ Application acceptance time: Weekdays (Including Holidays) : 9:00 am - 12:00 pm, Sat. & Sun.: 9:00 am - 12:00 pm, 1:00 pm - 3:00 pm
 - ◆ Carrying-in place: Bulky Waste Collection and Disposal Center in Kota-cho (Map (3) 14-1 Zundayama, Kiriya)
- Caution: Please provide your identification card such as a drivers license or a health insurance card that certifies you live in Kota-cho. If a storm warning is issued by 7:00am, no collection will be carried out. Please also note that there is no back-up day in such an event.

Door-to-door collection (Charged)

- ◆ Application: Call either of the following offices to reserve a collection time during the application acceptance period (marked on the above calendar) for every month. Natsume Unyu Co., Ltd. - ◆ Purchase of payment labels: Available in supermarkets in town and the Environment Section at the town office. Please purchase the required number of payment labels for bulky waste (300 yen for one label) One label is required for each article irrespective of item and size.
- ◆ Carrying-out: After affixing the payment label on the trash before the reserved date, put it out in front of the entrance by the designated time. (For apartments, put trash out near the doorway on the 1st floor.) Affix the payment label at an easy-to-see location.

Collectable garbage

- *Some types of bulky waste other than the following items cannot be collected. Please contact us in advance.
- ◆ Electric, gas and oil appliances: rice cookers, audio devices, electric fans, microwaves vacuum, etc.
 - ◆ Furniture, bedclothes and furnishing goods, other: drawers, sofas, beds, stoves, bicycles, futon,



Recyclable waste collection at permanent collection sites

Application acceptance days: As per the collection calendar
 Application acceptance time: 9:00 am - 3:00 pm
 Carrying-in place: Parking lot located down Sakazaki Elementary School (Map①), Kota-cho Health Center (Map②), Bulky Waste Collection and Disposal Center in Kota-cho (Map③)
 If a storm warning is issued by 7am, no collection will be carried out. Please also note that there is no back-up day in such an event.

Category	Items
Newspapers - Flyers	Bind it with string by classification.
Magazines	Magazines, books, school textbooks, copy paper.
Cardboards	Compared cardboard, cardboard, press board.
Cartons	Cartons without glue or in the middle.
Mixed paper	Paper other than newspaper or paper cartons.
Used clothing	Used clothing, shoes, towels.
Aluminum Cans, Steel Cans	Wash before putting out.
Small Appliances	Wash before putting out.

Weekday recyclable waste collection at permanent collection sites

Recyclable waste collection is carried out at permanent collection sites for residents who can put out papers on weekdays only and residents who cannot put out recyclable waste in the recyclable waste station in your area on the designated day and time.
 Collection items: Items that can be brought to separation stations, old papers, used clothing
 Application acceptance days: Monday through Friday
 Application acceptance hours: 9:00 am - 3:00 pm
 Carrying-in place: Kota Branch Office, Chubu Hozen Co., Ltd.(Map②)
 * Your name, address, and telephone number are required at the time of application acceptance.
